Leaving a Legacy

Many people find it comforting to know that they can continue helping others after their death. Your bequest to the Peoples Kitchen in your will would be an act of caring by which you would be remembered in years to come. It may be that you can reduce the inheritance tax your beneficiaries may have to pay by making a legacy to charity.

Why it is important to make a will.

Many people think that if they die without making a will their estate automatically goes to their next of kin or partner when they die. However it is possible that your entire estate could go to the Crown. Making a will is the only way for you to plan how to take care of your family, friends and support your favourite charities after your death.

What should you do?

If you wish to include a gift to The Peoples Kitchen in your will please give your solicitors our Registered Charity Number 1036149 and address 56 Bath Lane, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 5SQ.

There are three forms of legacy you might like to consider:

A [Pecuniary Legacy](#) is a specific cash sum which you mention in your will

A [Residuary Legacy](#) is the residue, or a share of the residue of your estate, after all other legacies, debts, inheritance tax and expenses have been paid

A [Legacy of Property](#).

If you want to alter an existing will you can add a Codicil for any of the three legacy types mentioned above.

A will is a legal document. We would strongly advise you to seek professional advice from a solicitor or from the Trustee Department of your bank if you wish to draw up a new will or alter an existing will. Words that might be appropriate for a Pecuniary Legacy

Words that might be appropriate for a Residuary Legacy

I give, devise and bequeath to the Peoples Kitchen Limited of 56 Bath Lane, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 5SQ, Registered Charity number 1036149 a share of of the residue of my estate to be applied by the Percy Hedley Foundation for its general charitable purposes, and I further direct that the official receipt of the Peoples Kitchen Limited for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.

Words that might be appropriate for a Legacy of Property
